	Architecture, Engineering, and Construction Technologies Students will learn basic drawing skills using various software including AutoCAD, Sketchup and REVIT. Students will create drawings of a structure and construct a model of the structure. Through this process the student will gain insight and career opportunities available in the AEC industry.	
	Automotive Technology Students will gain an understanding of the automotive industry and careers available, knowledge of nomenclature of basic tools and basic usage, shop safety, on-line technical reference usage, as well as an overview of the eight areas of automotive technology courses offered at HonCC.	
	Carpentry Technology Students will learn about the carpentry industry, practice quality workmanship, use appropriate materials, tools, equipment and procedures to carry out work as a carpentry professional. This session will culminate in producing a final project.	

Cosmetology Students will learn about the Cosmetology program through hands-on activities and experiential instruction. We will discuss different aspects of the industry and options for career paths. At the end of the two weeks, students will understand how the program works and what being in the beauty industry entails.
Computing, Security, & Network Technology Computing, Security, & Network Technology program is one of our most popular programs. CSNT will provide you with a firm foundation in the basics of computers, networking, and information systems.
Diesel Mechanics Technology Students will gain an understanding of the Diesel Mechanics industry and careers available, knowledge of nomenclature of basic tools and basic usage, shop safety, on-line technical reference usage, as well as an overview of the diesel mechanics courses offered at HonCC.
